Step-by-Step Instructions:

- 1. Students are responsible for a management training session focusing on consumer rights and responsibilities.
- 2. Students should conduct research and develop a handout to present to the managers attending the training session.

Include:

- a) A description of how legislation defines and protects consumer rights.
- b) Explain the arbitration process that is available to help consumers resolve business disputes.
- c) Describe legal actions that may be taken to resolve consumer business disputes (e.g., small claims court, class action suits).
- 3. Using interview guide sheet, students interview local business-people, the police department, and the Chamber of Commerce, and prepare a report on the problems created by shoplifters. This report should include the extent of the problem for a business, the estimated amount of loss by the business, and the preventative measures being taken by the business.
- 4. Businesses having difficulty in collecting amounts that customers owe may hire collection agencies. Using the internet or media center resources, students prepare a report on collection agencies including what they do, what methods they use, and what their services cost.
