Levels of Phonological Awareness

1.	Concept of Word:	Counts the words in a short sentence. Recognizes that language is made up of letters that form words.
2.	Beginning Sound Recognition:	Identifies when two words begin with the same sound.
3.	Rhyming Word Recognition:	Identifies when two words rhyme.
4.	Beginning Sound Application:	Produces two words that begin with the same sound.
5.	Rhyming Word Application:	Names a word that rhymes with a given word.
6.	Syllable Segmentation:	Segments syllables in words.
7.	Onset and Rime Blending:	Blends and segments onsets and rimes to read and write words.
8.	Onset and Rime Segmentation:	Blends and segments onsets and rimes to read and write words.
9.	Phoneme Isolation:	Recognizes the beginning, middle, and ending sounds of spoken words.
10.	Phoneme Blending:	Blends and segments phonemes to read and write words.
11.	Phoneme Segmentation:	Blends and segments phonemes to read and write words.
12.	Phoneme Manipulation:	Manipulates beginning, middle, and ending Phonemes to create new words.
