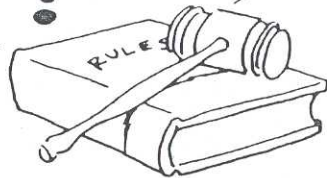


WHAT IS PARLIAMENTARY PROCEDURE ?

without confusion!

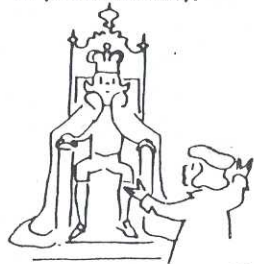
WHY is parliamentary procedure **IMPORTANT** ?

mentary Law.

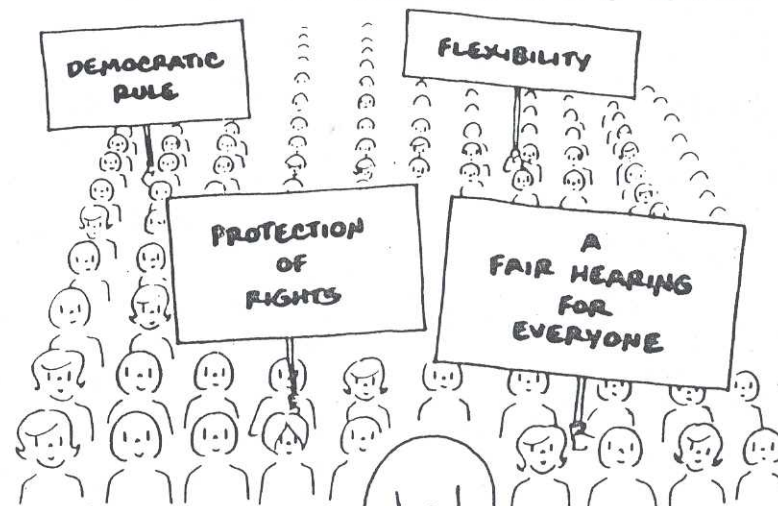
