Advanced Graphic Design Poster Design: Poster Design for a Social Cause

GPS: ACCT-AGD-4, ACCT-AGD-5

Objective: Given a computer loaded with the internet and a guideline sheet, design a poster for a social cause. Score an 80% or higher on the completed project.

READ ALL STEPS BEFORE STARTING!!!!

Step I

- a. Choose a social cause, such as helping the homeless. Gather information about it.
- b. Find related visuals to use as references.
- c. Write a design brief. Define the purpose and function of the poster, the audience, and the information to be communicated.
- d. Design a poster to promote helping others.

Step II

- a. Concentrate on finding a visual way to promote the cause. The purpose is to draw attention to the cause. For example, you can have statements like "Helping means..." or Being hungry means..." or pose a question like "What would you do with an extra ten dollars?"
- b. The poster should in include the web address so that people can act.
- c. Your design solution should grab the attention of people walking by.
- d. Produce 10 thumbnail sketches. You must have approval before going to the rough stage.

Step III

- a. Produce at least one rough draft before going to the computer. You Must have approval before going to computer.
- b. Be sure to establish visual hierarchy.
- c. The poster can be either a vertical format or a horizontal format.

Step IV

- a. Refine your rough draft. Create one computer.
- b. The size, shape, and proportion should be dictated by your strategy, design concept, and where the poster will be seen (environment). The poster size is 11x17.
