Creating an Inline (Looks like Outlined type)

1. Type the words you want to outline. Use your name at 150 points or smaller if it won't fit.

2. Using the selection tool, copy & paste a duplicate in front of the type you just created (it won't look any different because it is right on top of the other one).

3. On the bottom set of type, put NONE on the fill and a 3 pt. PMS 299 stoke

4. On the front set of type, make a white 1 pt. stroke and a PMS 485 fill

5. If you have moved them, line them up perfectly on top of each other as shown below. Select both sets of type, go to Window>Show Align and click both horizontal and vertical centers

6. Alter the fill and strokes to achieve the amount of white gap you would like.
