- What are examples of substrates it prints on?
- Group member names should appear on the back of poster

Printing Plate/ Printing Surface:

Using given foam board, each group will create a printing surface for the assigned process. The image that needs to appear on the printing surface:



The black represents the final placement of ink on the substrate. The dotted line represents the edge of the substrate.

What will the printing surface look like?
Remember that the printing surface may not be right-reading.
