LEARNING EXPERIENCES

Sequence of Instruction

1. Identify the Standards. Standards should be posted in the classroom for each lesson.

2. Review Essential Questions.

- What is a leader and how do I become one?
- What are the roles of team members?
- How is HOSA related to healthcare science?

3. Identify and review the unit vocabulary.

4. Assessment Activity.

Instruction

- Introduce the lesson by using a teambuilding activity.

- 2. After discussing above activity, have students brainstorm in small groups the qualities they believe a leader should possess. Bring the groups together and list the qualities on the board. Discuss which ones they think are most important. Give students a list of leadership qualities in HOSA Advisor Handbook, Section C found at: http://www.hosa.org/natorg/SectionC.pdf
- **3.** Ask students to identify types of teams and discuss the role of team members within some of the teams identified, such as Football Team, Dance Team, Discuss roll of healthcare team, the different members and their roles.
- 4. Discuss what it means to be a member of HOSA using the HOSA Handbook Section C.
- 5. Have students complete the HOSA Scavenger Hunt.
- 6. Administer Statesman Award Test at end of lesson.

Students will:

- Define qualities of a good leader.
- Complete HOSA Statesman Award activity/scavenger hunt.
- Organize community service project.

- Define Parliamentary procedure according to Robert's Rules of Order.
- Conduct "meetings" in classroom using parliamentary procedure guidelines.
- Complete Statesman Award Test for HOSA.

Notes & Reflections:

- Leadership and teamwork can be integrated throughout the semester by taking a day per month (for example) to set up classroom meetings using parliamentary procedures with different students. Each set has to rotate a turn, come up with an agenda and submit it for approval prior to the meeting.
- If your system has access to Georgia Public Broadcasting website, there is a video streaming segment on "Teamwork: A Skill You'll Need" that includes a quiz that is really good and also a segment on leadership "Doing the Right Thing..." that depicts high school students getting elected to leadership positions just on popularity and not being a good leader. It has good discuss questions after the video clip.
