Students with Disabilities:

For students with disabilities, the instructor should refer to the student's IEP to be sure that the accommodations specified are being provided appropriately. Instructors should also familiarize themselves with the provisions of Behavior Intervention Plans that may be part of a student's IEP. LESSON PLANS

Instructional planning:

• LESSON 1: WHAT IS LEADERSHIP?

1. Identify the standards. Standards should be posted in the classroom.

MSHS7-HS-3: The student will describe the attributes of effective teamwork and leadership.

- a) Define leadership and state the qualities of a leader.
 - b) Describe Career and Technical Student Organizations and their importance in leadership development, and identify benefits of belonging to Health Occupations Students of America (HOSA).
2. Review Essential Question(s). Post Essential Questions in the classroom.
 - What is leadership?
 - What are some qualities of a successful leader?
 3. Identify and review the unit vocabulary. Terms may be posted on word wall.

4. Interest approach – Mental set

Leadership definition activity:

Ask the class what their definition of what leadership is.

Have a few students share their answer with the class.

Possible answers:

- Someone in the office of a leader
- Someone who others look to for guidance
- Someone in control of a situation

Ask the class "Who are some good leaders in our community, state, and nation?"

Possible answers:

- President
- Senator
- Preacher
- Etc.

5. Leadership quotes activity:

Print the provided **Leadership Quotes** or find others that you like. Tape these quotes around the room; but make sure your students can find them. Have your students get up and read the quotes.

Then have them choose the one that they like the best. Have the students that choose the same quote group up and write a paragraph about why they like the quote and fill in the **Leadership Quote Worksheet**.

6. **Leadership Styles Game**: Play this game with your class. Have them break up into teams and the winning team gets 5 extra credit points added to their quiz grade.

7. **Leadership Worksheet**: Have your class complete this worksheet.

- Review the worksheet.
- Discuss the answers as a class.

8. Summary: Ask students at random one of the following questions:

- After completing this lesson who in our community do you think of as a good leader?
- Name a quality of a good leader.
- Why is leadership training important?

• **LESSON 2: WHAT IS TEAMWORK?**

1. Review Essential Questions. Post Essential Questions in the classroom.

- What is teamwork and why is it important?

2. Have your class complete the **Teamwork Skills Worksheet**.

- Review the worksheet.
- Discuss the answers as a class.

3. Lead a general discussion on teamwork.

Ask students why is teamwork important?

- Why is it good or bad?
- What do you like about teamwork?

4. **Teamwork Skills Game:** Play this game with your class. Have them break up into teams and the winning team will win a prize.
5. Summary: Ask students at random one of the following questions:
 - What is teamwork?
 - Name one teamwork skill.
 - Why is teamwork important?

• LESSON 3: CAREER TECHNICAL STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS/HOSA

1. Review Essential Questions. Post Essential Questions in the classroom.
 - What are Career and Technical Student Organizations?
 - How would being a member of HOSA benefit you?
2. **Why join HOSA:** Show this PowerPoint to your class. Make sure they take notes so that they can study for their HOSA Statesman test.
3. **HOSA Scavenger Hunt:** Have your students complete this activity. It will help them prepare for their statesman test and help them become familiar with HOSA.
4. **HOSA Word Search:** Have your students complete this word search, it will help them become familiar with HOSA terms.
5. **HOSA Statesman:** Have your students take this practice statesman test for a test grade. They will become familiar with the types of questions that will be on their statesman test.

• LESSON 4: PROFESSIONAL ORGANIZATIONS IN HEALTHCARE

1. Review Essential Questions. Post Essential Questions in the classroom.
 - What are the professional organizations for the healthcare industry and why are they important?
2. Demonstration: **Strength in Numbers Activity**
3. **Professional Organizations Worksheet:** Pass out this worksheet to your class and go to the computer lab. Explain to the class what professional organizations are. Have them complete the worksheet using the internet for research in this area.

• LESSON 5: INCORPORATING MATHEMATICS

1. Students complete **Math in CTAE Parliamentary Procedure 1** which emphasizes the use of mathematics in voting.
2. Review above worksheet with students. The answer key attached to the worksheet includes brief explanations.
3. With time permitting, students will complete **Math in CTAE Parliamentary Procedure 2.**
